



## Wind Rose

The diagram is a wind rose with eight arms extending from a central point. The arms are labeled as follows: NW (top-left), N (top), NE (top-right), E (right), SE (bottom-right), S (bottom), SW (bottom-left), and W (left). Each arm consists of a series of squares: NW has 8 squares, N has 8 squares, NE has 8 squares, E has 8 squares, SE has 8 squares, S has 8 squares, SW has 8 squares, and W has 8 squares. The labels are placed at the end of each arm, closest to the center.

Each day shade in a square to show the direction that the wind is *coming* from.

You may want to also add letter codes in each shaded square to show the type of weather it brings. These could be; r= rain, s=snow, d= dry, vh=very hot, vc= very cold.
